SPELLING: LOOK FOR THE LIST IN THE MOOSE BOOK.

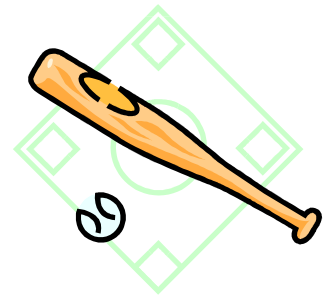
WELCOME TO 5TH GRADE!
